

# The twentieth Sunday after Pentecost October 26-27, 2019 - Rite II



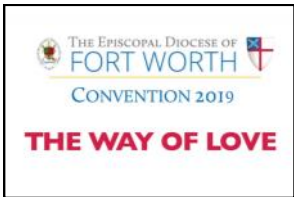
