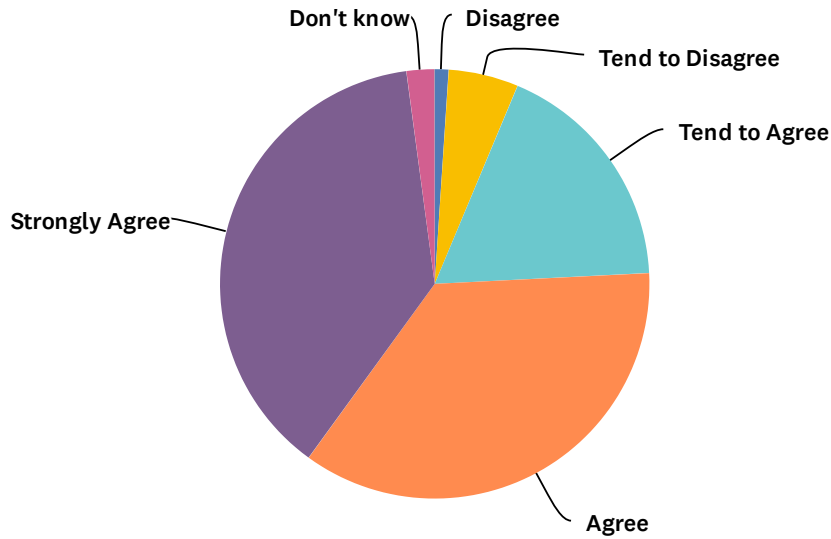


## Q86 I believe our congregation has done a good job at adapting during this pandemic so that we stay connected.

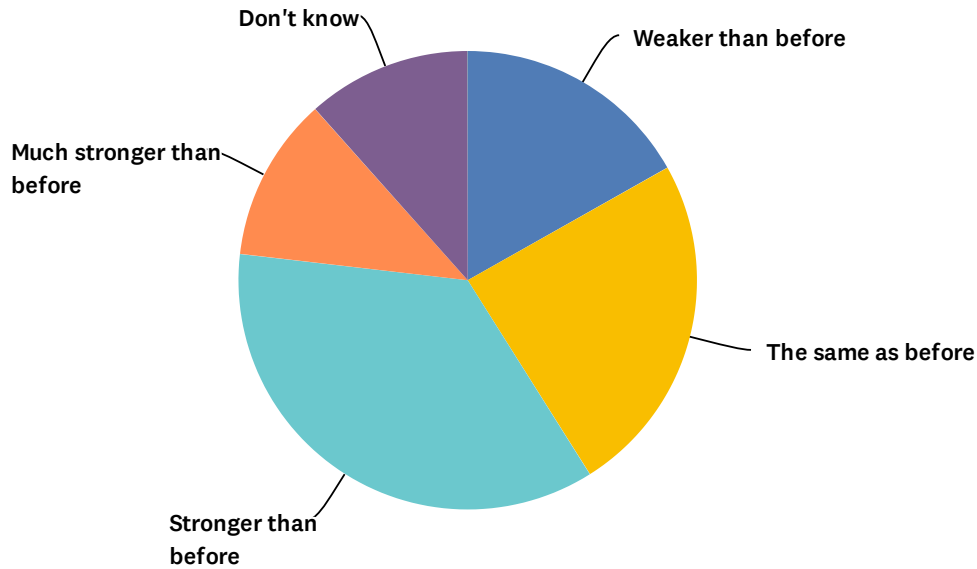

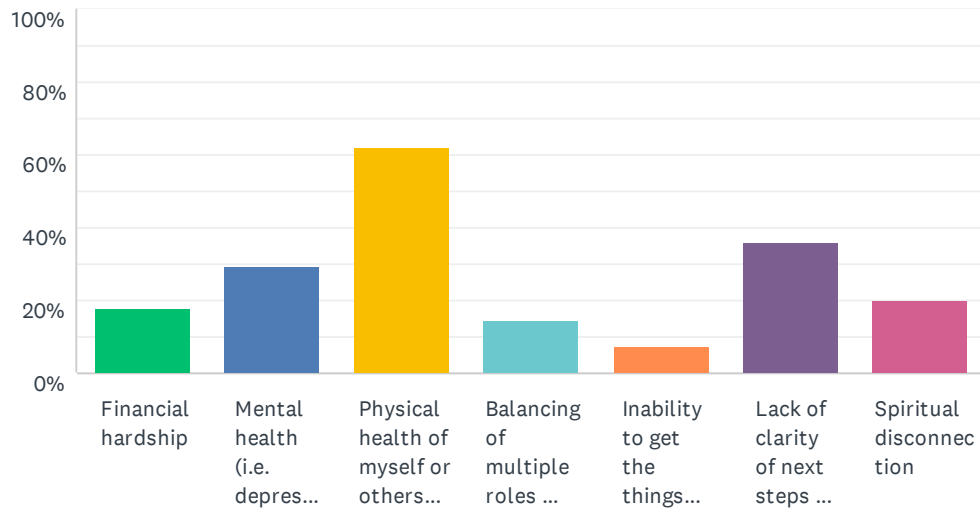
