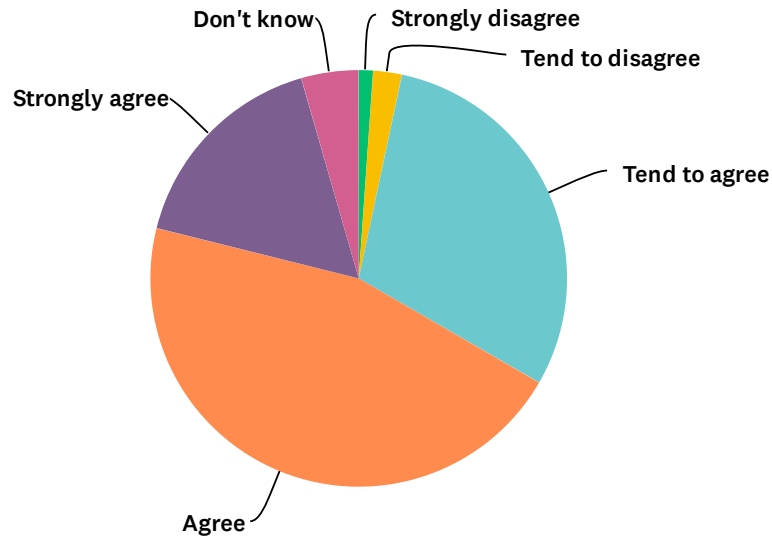


## Q96 Our worship services prepare me to live a Christian life that makes a difference in the world.

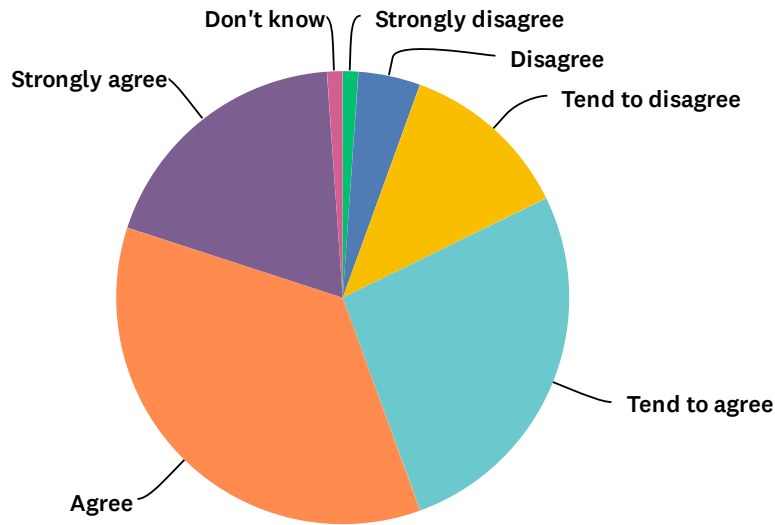

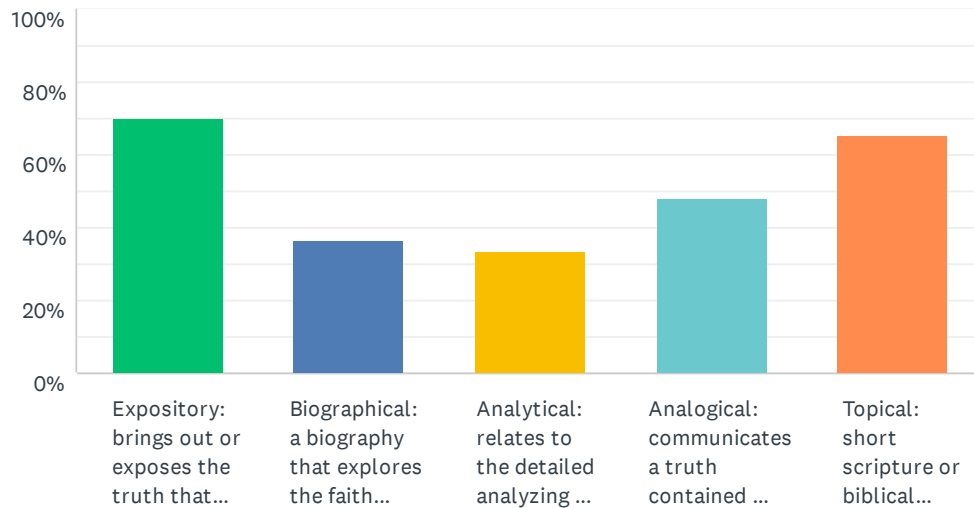

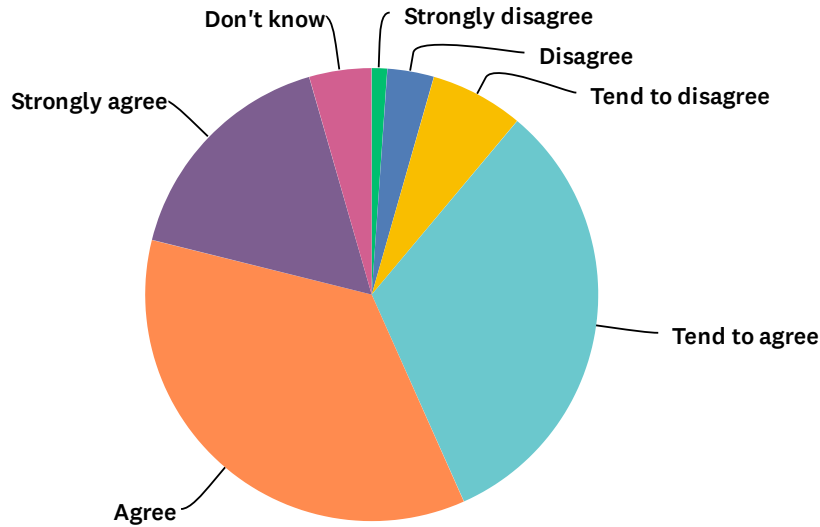

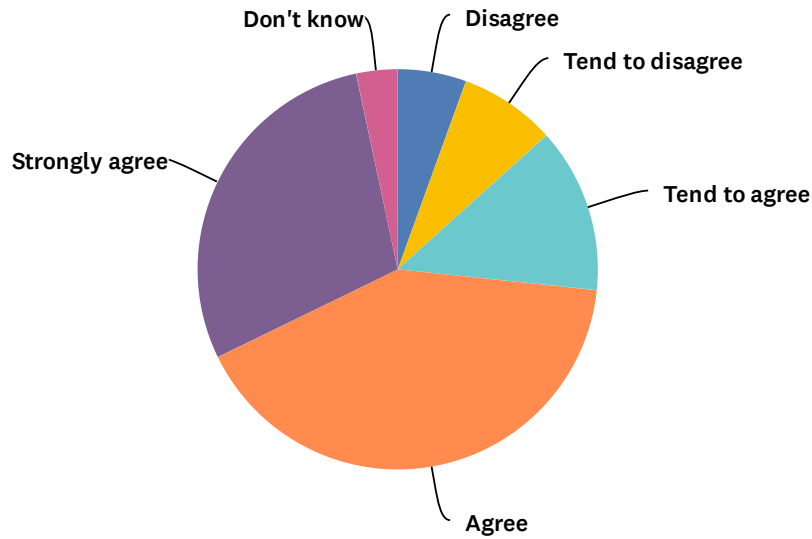

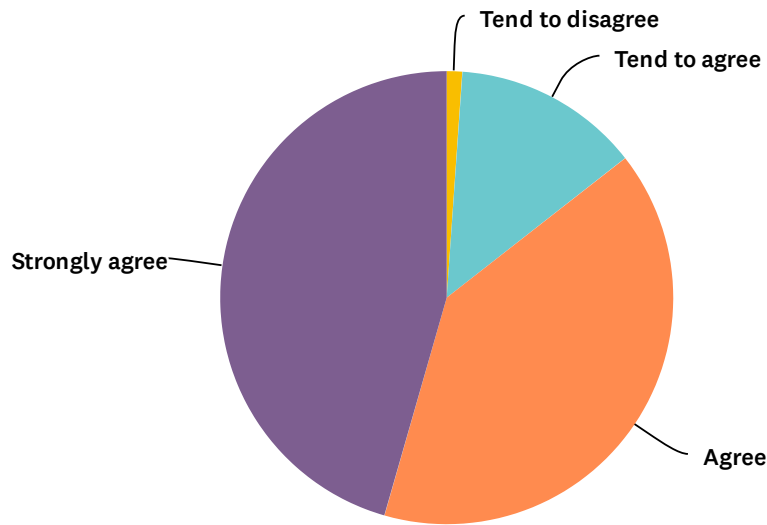

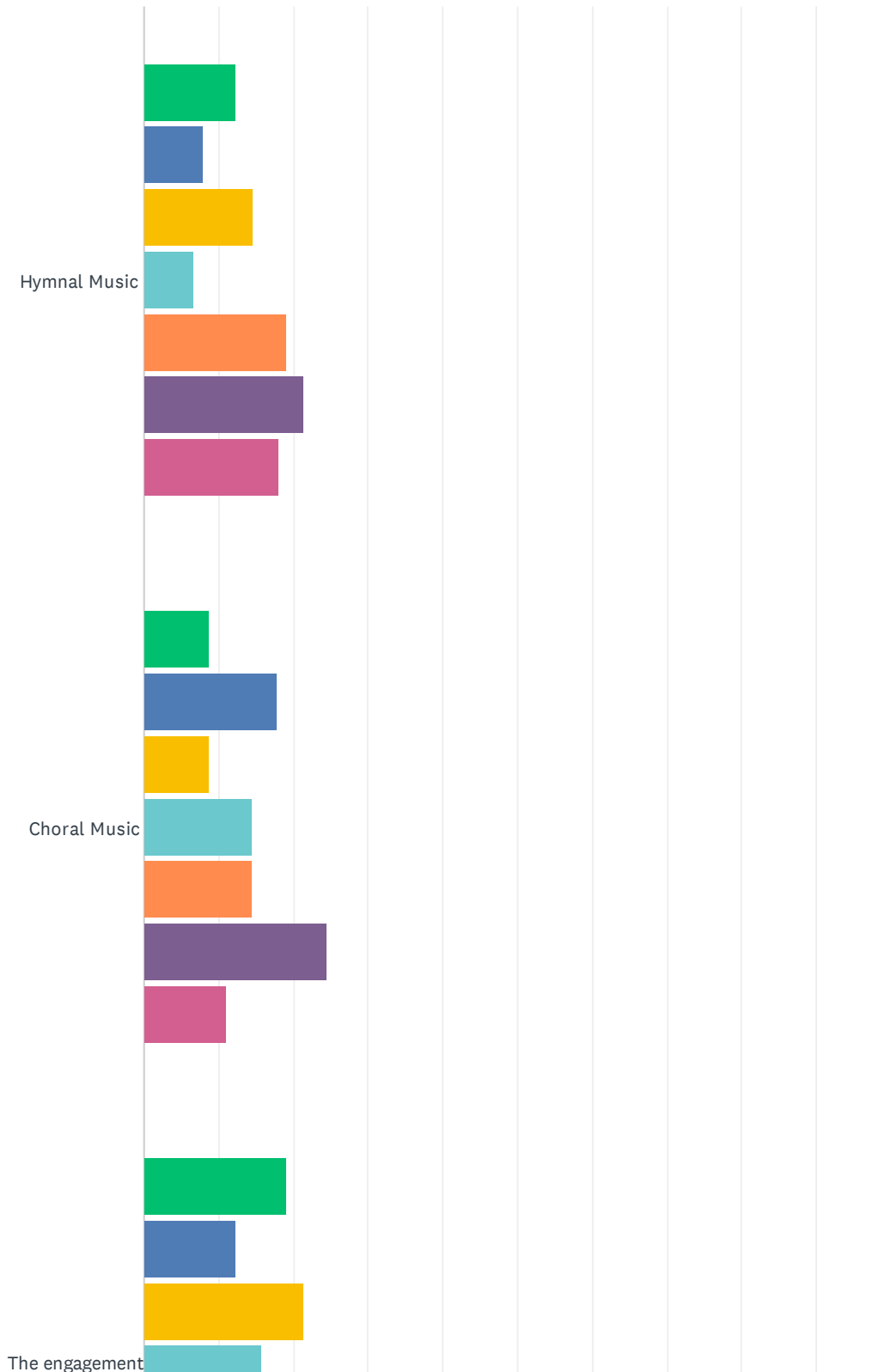

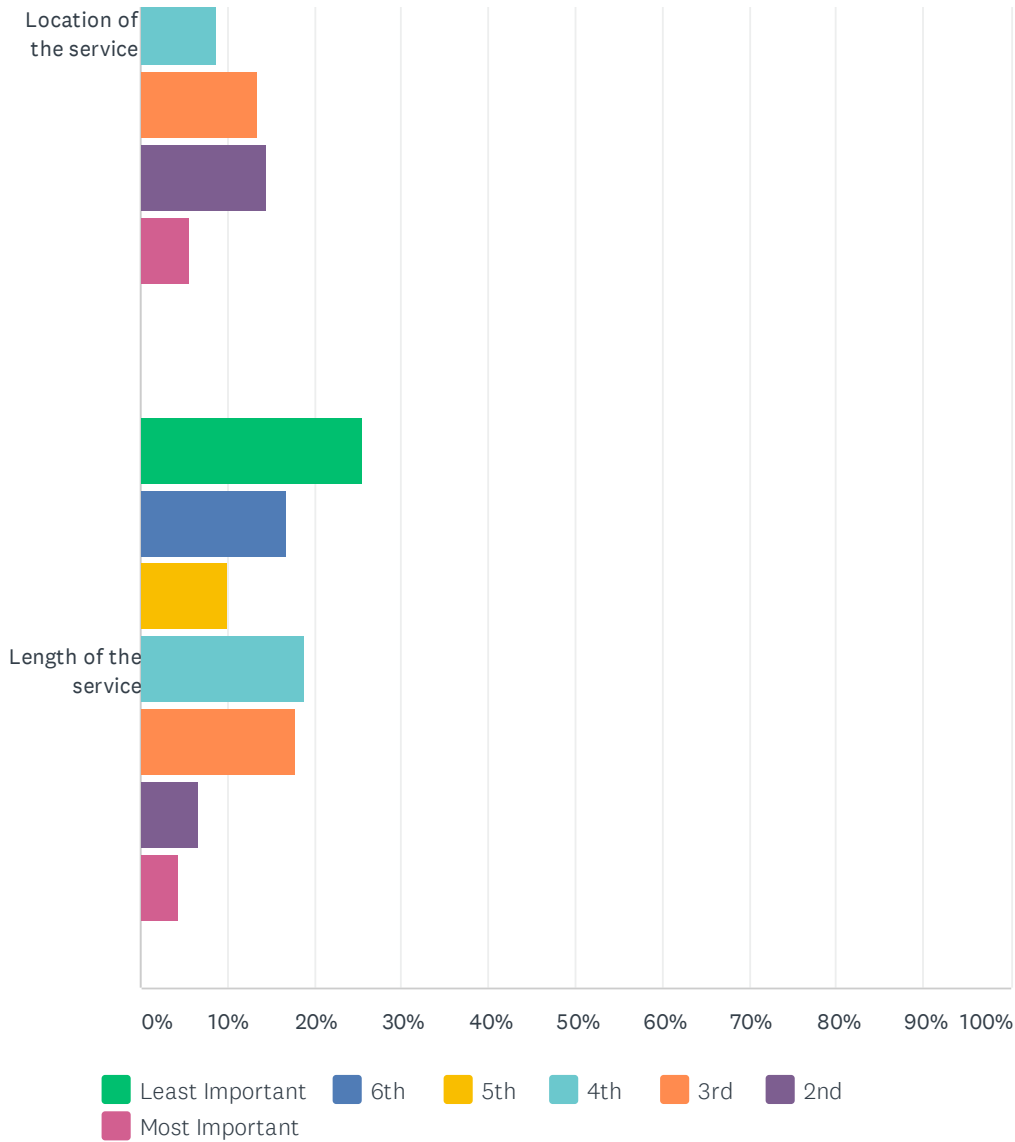
