A YEAR WITH MANY CHALLENGES AND RESOLVE

Our Neighbors Need 4Saints Food Pantry.

The pantry has experienced a substantial increase in demand, including:

- An 88% increase in food distributions this year highlights the critical need in the E. Lancaster Ave. Our service zip codes are identified as one of Texas' highest poverty and food insecurity areas.
- We now serve 650 clients monthly and register an average of 40 new clients weekly.
- Tarrant Area Food Bank Mobile Pantry delivers more fresh produce and dairy more than ever.





Inflation Impacts Food and Delivery Costs.

Rising food costs and the growing number of families continue to be challenging. Critical funding is required to allow 4Saints to distribute fresh, healthy food weekly. 4Saints now serves more families than ever, requiring additional delivery and transportation fees.

We Moved, Yet Again.

In February 2023, we moved to our new temporary home at Meadowbrook-Poly United Methodist Church.

Heartache and growing expenses has only strengthened our resolve and our desire to meet the growing needs of our neighbors.
