

St. Martin in the Fields Family and Scouts Outdoor Movie and Camping Event
6:00 PM Friday, October 30, 2020 to 9:00 AM Saturday, October 31, 2020

Program Objectives: Leverage St. Martin's *fields* to provide an outside, distanced, family-friendly activity to reinforce fellowship, connect with others, have some fun, and show our reverence to God.

Safety:

- COVID pre-screening [questionnaire](#) and contactless temperature check on arrival.
- Families bring their own hand sanitizer, blanket, chairs, flashlights, and if camping, tent, sleeping bags, pillows, mats, cots, blankets, etc.
- Families sit and eat together at least 15' from other families. Tents 20' apart.
- Unless eating or camping, wear mask.
- Food served in disposable individual containers, individual condiments.
- Handwashing station, hand sanitizer available.
- Church office restrooms, each family Lysol after using.

Youth protection protocols:

- Only family members tent together.
- Two-deep adult leadership always present unless for parent/child.
- Youth to stay in the immediate visible area and be accompanied by parent to use the restroom.

Location: North side of sanctuary.

- Movies and meals around the outdoor worship area. Each family will have their own space.
- Camping will be in tents spread out near the fence line.

Program:

- 6:00-6:30: Arrival and check-in. (Liza).
 - Family scavenger hunt welcome activity (Paula).
 - Set-up tents in family camping style. Only family members may be in the same tent. Plenty of room to spread-out. (Scouts lead tent placement and assist as needed).
 - Skit scripts passed out and rehearsals. (Scouts).
- 6:30-6:45: Dinner served. (Christopher & Aaron). Prayer (Paula).
 - Grilled hot dogs in individual paper containers, individual small chip bags, eat at your seating area.
 - Bring water bottles and bottled water available.
 - Cub Scouts supply food, donations accepted. Cub Scouts have popcorn available for sale.
- 6:38: Sunset.
- 6:45-8:10 First Halloween movie -child friendly: Rated G.
- 8:10-8:30: Campfire Program
 - Roast s'mores over campfire. One family at a time, disposable roasting sticks.
 - Youth skits - preapproved only. Masks and 6' distance required.
- 8:30-10: Second Halloween movie - more youth focused: Rated PG.
- 10:00-10:15: Evening program: Song (Liza), Cubmaster Minute (Christopher), and Evening Prayer (Paula).
- 10:15: Families to tents or home.
- 7:40-8:00 breakfast. (Christopher & Aaron). Prayer (Paula).
 - Breakfast - individually wrapped breakfast burritos, donuts.
 - Coffee, water available. Individual cups.

- Cub Scouts supply food, donations accepted. Cub Scouts have popcorn available for sale.
- 7:46: Sunrise.
- 8:00-8:45: Family worship service. (Paula).
 - Mass on the grass (pending)
 - Invite parish to bring lawn chairs and worship outside.
- 8:45-9:00: Cleanup. (Christopher announcement, everyone polices).
- 9:00 Dismissal.
